


# Class B Autumn Term 2017




#### Literacy

In literacy we will be studying and writing non-fiction texts including news reports, instructions, information leaflets and letters. Alongside this, we will be writing myths, poems and stories. Regular spelling and grammar lessons throughout the term will support the development of the children's writing which will include studying direct speech, sentence structure, punctuation and grammatical features such as adverbs.

#### Maths

In maths we will be starting by working on our number bonds to 10 and 20.



We will also be working on written methods of addition and subtraction including 3 and 4 digit numbers, alongside using inverse calculations to check our answer.

At the end of each week, we will be using what we have learnt to help solve word problems in order to deepen our understanding.

Times tables are an essential part of Y3/Y4 maths so it is essential for children to practise these at home.



In science we will be looking be looking at plants, animals including humans and nutrition.
