

PE and Sport Premium Funding September (Academic Year 2015 – 2016) £8,356

From September 2013, Furness Vale Primary School has received Government funding to improve the quality and breadth of PE and Sports Provision. The funding continues to fund improvements in the provision of PE and Sport so that all pupils further develop healthy lifestyles.

It will be used effectively to

- Provide weekly staff training by UK Sports on how to teach PE well. Staff in Foundation Stage and Years 1/2/3/4 work alongside qualified coaches in lessons to increase their subject knowledge and confidence.
- Buy into the School Sports Partnership for local schools High Peak School and Sport Partnership.
- Contribute to cost of a School Sports Coordinator (SSCO) in the local cluster who will run competitions and provide support for teachers and PE Subject leaders.
- Train all of the children in Years 5/6 to be Playtime Leaders in Autumn 2015 by the SSCO.
- Continue to employ a qualified coach to organise sports games on two lunchtimes each week.
- Provide specialist coaching for lacrosse (2 terms) and cricket (1 term) for the children in Year 4/5/6. Links with local community sports Clubs are also established.
- To pay for transport to Cluster Sports events.
- To fund new PE and Sports equipment for use in school.

In 2015 – 2016, as skills continue to improve, there have been notable successes in Cluster Sports Events: 1st place in the Girls' 6-a-side football tournament, 3rd place in the Boys' 6-a-side football tournament and 3rd place in the cross-country relays.
