### Topic



This terms topic is based around the text *The Bogler's Apprentice* by Rachael Lindsay, we will be incorporating history, geography, art and D.T into our topic lessons.

### Literacy

In literacy we will be studying and writing fiction texts, in particular *The Dragon Machine* and *The Bogler's Apprentice*.


Alongside this, we will also be writing myths and reports.

The children will continue to learn about internet safety and coding.




# Religious Education
