


# Class C Summer Term 2017

# Literacy

Produce an information leaflet about the lifecycle of butterflies.


Write about the life of Van Gogh.

# Numeracy



Continue to develop our understanding of the four basic operations; including solving word problems.

Understanding place value and what each digit represents in a number.

Working on fractions of shapes and quantities. Measuring and reading scales.





We are having caterpillars in our classroom that we will watch develop into butterflies!

We will be growing plants and learning the names of the different parts and seeing what happens if plants don't get their basic requirements.

# Religious Education

### Geography
