Activities are introduced at YOUR level, at carefully chosen sites, using all necessary safety equipment, which is provided by the Centre. White Hall conforms fully to the requirements of the 'Adventure Activities Licensing Authority' and has a licence. However, you must understand that adventure activities, by their nature, involve an element of risk, which cannot be totally eliminated. Having said that, White Hall has an excellent safety record.
