### Literacy

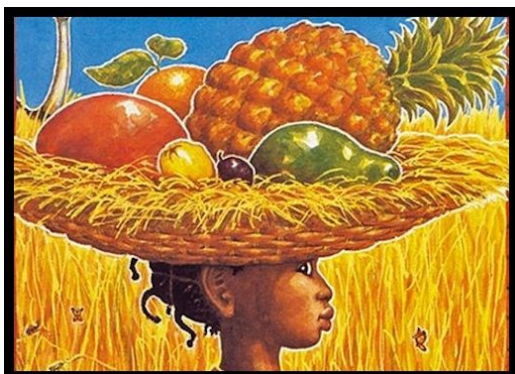
We will start the term by looking at the story of 'The Enormous Turnip'.

We will write some food poems, concentrating on the smells and sounds of our favourite foods cooking. We will find out about where and how some exotic foods grow and write a report about it.

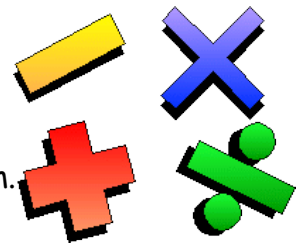
We will also review the current 'snack' policy at playtimes and write to Mrs. Taylor expressing our views on playtime snacks.



We will also take inspiration from the story "Handa's Surprise".

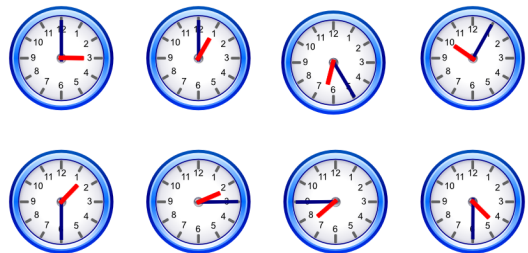
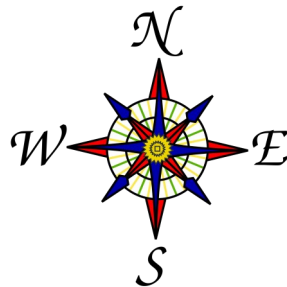
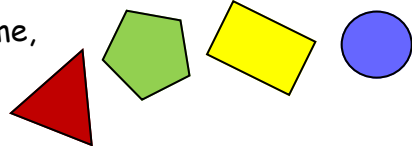
## Numeracy

We will look at the types of foods we need to keep healthy and also how animals obtain their food from plants and other animals and explore simple food chains.

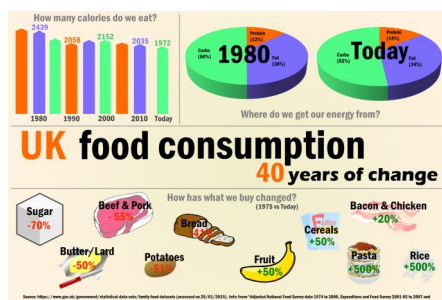


We hope to spend some time in the school garden growing our own foods.

We will consider where our food comes from and the distance it travels to reach our plates.

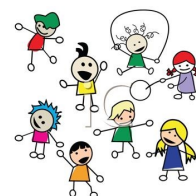
We will compare some of these areas with our own environment.

## ICT

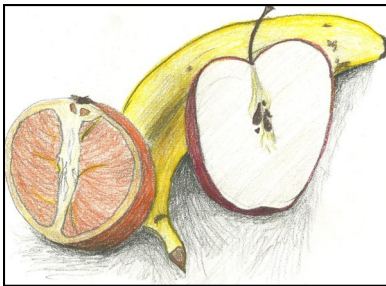


In our coding lessons we will continue to write simple programmes to make objects move in different ways and make them disappear in increasingly elaborate ways!
