Throughout the term we will be looking at the Titanic and basing a lot of our literacy around this topic.


Literacy


In literacy we will be continuing to use Talk 4 writing in order to help us understand different text types.

This term we will focus on instruction writing, diaries and newspaper reports.


Maths

In maths this term we will be using mastery maths, to help embed mathematical knowledge so that the children can answer questions confidently both with fluency and understanding.










In science we will be looking at sound, rocks and light.
