Literacy

This year Reception, Y1 and Y2 will be using the Read Write Ink scheme.



Read, Write Ink aims to enhance and improve reading and spelling and will form the basis of our daily literacy lessons.



However, our topic this term will provide plenty of extra writing opportunities.

We will write a diary entry of a London resident and write a fact-file about The Great Fire of London.

We will also write firework poems.



Numeracy

We will work on place value, counting and recognising an increasing amount of numbers and learning what each digit represents.

We will count in 2s, 5s and 10s and work on one more and one less.

We will work on recognising and describing 2D and 3D shapes.







Money, money, money!

We will look at the value of coins and make given amounts and work practically to solve problem relating to mass.

Science



Investigate the best materials for re-building new houses in the city.



Learn about the changes to different materials when heated.

Investigate different light sources.

Religious Education



We will learn about the Hindu festival of Diwali, listen to the story of Rama and Sita and act it out.

In our coding lessons we will learn to write simple programmes to make objects move.

We will use the internet to look at pictures of The Great Fire of London and we will word process some of our work.

Music

Learn and perform the song 'London's Burning' and combine sounds to make a piece of music about the great fire.

Art / DT

We will make Tudor houses and recreate our own 'Great Fire of London' experience.





We will experiment with colour mixing and silhouette work to create our 'London's Burning' paintings.

We will make salt dough bread for use in our role play area.

For bonfire night we will design and make a rocket, make parkin.





PSHE

Focusing on New beginnings, learning new daily routines, settling in to new learning environment, establishing class rules and learning behaviour expectations.

We will also concentrate on fire safety.
