Literacy

We will write postcards from the rainforest and write a newspaper article about a new species of animal that we discover!










Numeracy




We will be taking a look at multiplication as 'groups of' and division as 'sharing'.

We will be comparing, ordering and measuring length, height and mass.










Science


Our visiting sports coaches will be with us on Monday afternoons.

Religious Education


We will be learning about The Creation story.
