- English/Art: We have just celebrated World Book Day. Design and make yourself a special bookmark to use when you are reading. You could decorate the bookmark with your own pictures and patterns as well as your favourite story images. Make sure it is colourful and long-lasting. Why not add a tassel!
- Maths: Create a poster to display in the classroom to help someone learn about fraction and decimal equivalents eg $\frac{1}{2} = 0.5$, $\frac{1}{5} = 0.20$. Use visual representations (pictures).
