To help the children independently learn about money, we have a café in the role play area which is very popular.

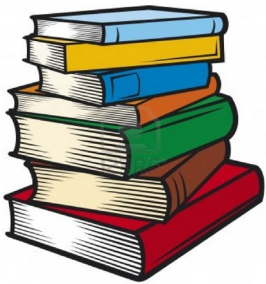
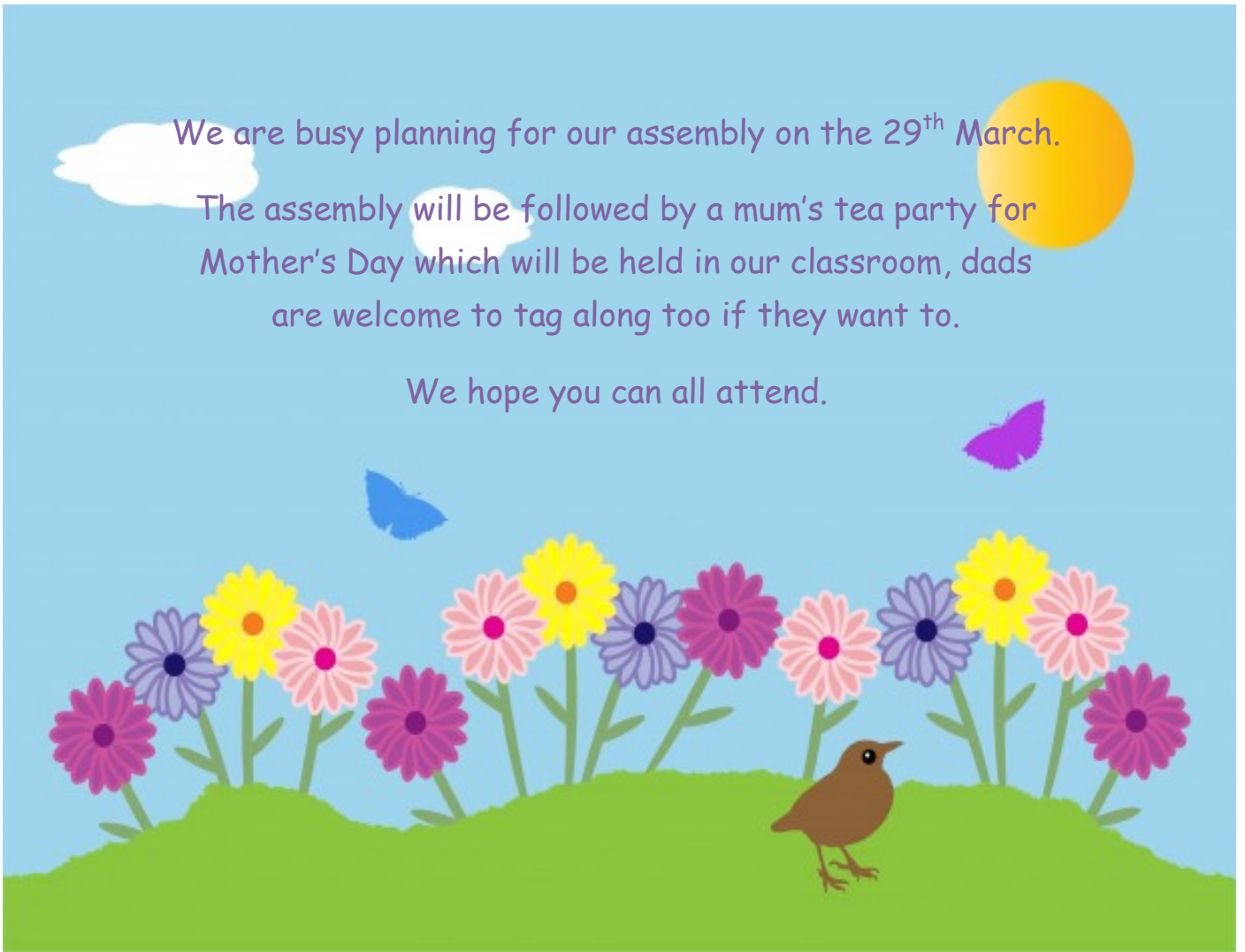
## UK Money
