Forest School sessions are being run on a Wednesday afternoon.

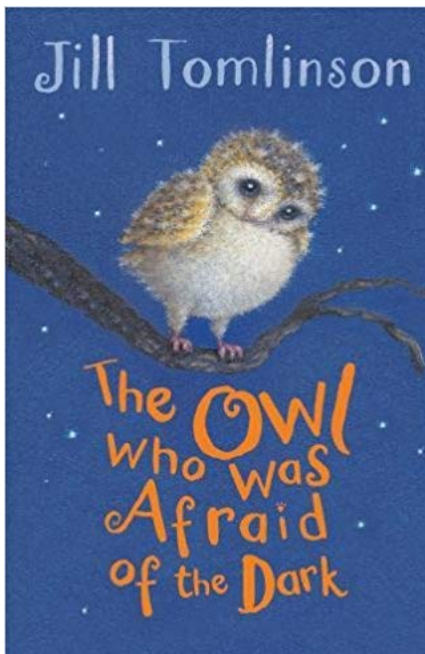
The children love our outings and they are valuable to the children's learning and development. Please could you make sure your child has a pair of wellies at school or bring them in on a Wednesday.
