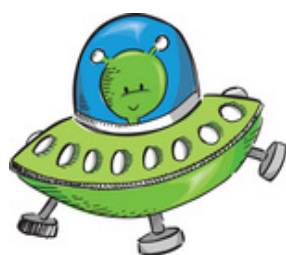


On Tuesday we went on our Christmas trip to Matlock Farm, the children enjoyed acting out a short nativity and meeting the animals. They also had fun in the play area.
