2. Maths: This week in maths we have been learning about rounding numbers to the nearest 10,100 and 1000. For your homework can you write steps for success on how to round to the nearest 100,000 and 1,000,000
3. Spellings: Can you write 2 sentences for each of your spellings. As an extra challenge can you create a paragraph in which you include all of your spellings.
4. Literacy: For literacy this week we have been learning about recounts, for your homework can you write a recount of your weekend?
5. Topic: Our topic this term is Ancient Egypt, for your homework can you create a PowerPoint about Pharaohs? (you can choose to present your findings in a different way if you wish)
