

Brain Builder Book

Basics: times tables, spellings and reading – these must be done throughout the week. Children will be tested/assessed on their spellings and times tables on Thursdays.

Then choose one of the following or you can do more than one if you like. If you want to do something different that still links to what we've been learning in school, then you can do that instead! The choice is yours.

Rules: no more than 2 pages of your book and it must be presented neatly.

1. News: 'Queens speech' One of the news items was about the queen's speech this week. So, for your homework can you research what the queen's speech is, why the queen does a speech and when they take place. You can choose any news item from the last week.
2. Maths: In maths we are learning about division. Can you create a worksheet for another child to complete which includes: Fluency questions, Problem solving questions and word problems. For an extra challenge can you include a part-part-whole model?
3. Spellings: Can you write 2 sentences for each of your spellings. As an extra challenge can you create a paragraph in which you include all of your spellings.
4. Literacy - Can you research what a dash is and why they are used. Then create a poster which explains how to use a dash. (Can you research how to use a double dash?)
