

## Brain Builder Book

Basics: times tables, spellings and reading – these must be done throughout the week. Children will be tested/assessed on their spellings and times tables on Thursdays.

**Then choose one of the following or you can do more than one if you like. If you want to do something different that still links to what we've been learning in school, then you can do that instead! The choice is yours.**

**Rules: no more than 2 pages of your book and it must be presented neatly.**

1. News: 'Google is 21 years old' was the main headline on Newsround this week. For your homework I'd like you to find out all the key information about the world's most used search engine.
2. Maths: This week in maths we have been looking at how we can answer word problems in a more efficient way. For your homework can you challenge Mr Waring with your best 10 word problems? You must know the answer!
3. Spellings: Can you write 2 sentences for each of your spellings. As an extra challenge can you create a paragraph in which you include all of your spellings.
4. **YEAR 6 MUST DO AT LEAST ONE PAGE ON THIS** - Literacy: For literacy this week I would like you to research 'modal verbs' and then create either a poster or a PowerPoint, teaching the class what they are.
5. Topic: Our topic this term is Ancient Egypt, for your homework can you research hieroglyphics and then create a piece of work using hieroglyphics. That could be: a crack the code sheet for someone to complete, a list of your family in hieroglyphics or even your classmates names! You decide...
