Basics: times tables, spellings and reading – these must be done throughout the week. Children will be tested/assessed on their spellings and times tables on Thursdays.

Then choose one of the following or you can do more than one if you like. If you want to do something different that still links to what we've been learning in school, then you can do that instead! The choice is yours.

Rules: no more than 2 pages of your book and it must be presented neatly.

1. News: 'Harvest time again' Research Harvest and find out why we celebrate it at this time of year. Present your findings in any way you like.
2. Maths: In maths we have been working on long multiplication – For your homework I'd like you to spend half an hour a night or the equivalent working on TT- Rockstar's. Your parents **must** write a note to prove you have completed this homework. I have attached your login details.
3. Spellings: Can you write 2 sentences for each of your spellings. As an extra challenge can you create a paragraph in which you include all of your spellings.
4. Literacy - (Y6) – Write a reflection on your day at high school – What did you enjoy? What did you not enjoy? Are you excited for high school? Why? (Y5) Write a reflection on your day in Manchester at the art gallery. What did you enjoy? What did you not enjoy as much? Did you enjoy the travel? Anything else you can remember from the day.
