- News: National Storytelling week will be celebrated from 1st – 8th February. Can you practise telling a simple, short story to an audience? It could be a well-known story or one that you make up. You could use prompt cards or draw a story map to help you remember but you must not read a story aloud! Maybe you could make some simple puppets to help. It would be great if you tell it to the class!
- Maths: Estimating and Measuring – Find six objects from around your house to measure accurately with a ruler or tape measure (estimate first).
- Topic: Nelson Mandela was an important man who came from the country of South Africa but who was he? Research him and record what you find out.
