We have started to do Forest schools again on a Wednesday morning, the children love exploring and enjoying the outdoors!

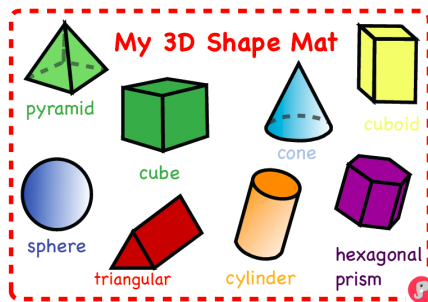
Please can you make sure your child brings a pair of wellies or boots in just in case it is muddy or raining. You are more than welcome to leave them on our welly rack in school.
