The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They **MUST** complete these task plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics

We have learnt about one more and one less in class.
Ask a grown-up to draw a spotty caterpillar. How many spots does it have?
Can you count them?
Can you draw a caterpillar that has one less spot?
Can you draw a caterpillar that has one more? Write the total number underneath the caterpillar.

Physical Development

We can see lots of pretty spring flowers.
Can you pretend to be a spring flower growing from a bulb?
Can you show the roots, leaves and flower growing?
Can you sway like a spring flower in the gentle breeze?
Can you show that the wind is getting stronger?

Literacy/Expressive Arts and Design

Google- Caterpillar shoes sweet rhyming bedtime stories. Listen and watch.

Design a pair of shoes for your favourite mini-beast from the story and write a sentence about why they are perfect for the mini-beast.

For eg: The spider has slippers to keep his feet cosy and warm.

Phonics

Play a game with your grown-up. Take it in turns to give instructions using fred talk.
For example, 'Touch your f-ee-t' or 'Stand u-p'.
