

Reception Home Learning - Thursday 2nd April 2020

The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They **MUST** complete these task plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics

We are going to learn about positional language. Positional language means using words such behind, on top, in front, next to. Can you listen and follow the instructions? Draw a bush in the middle of a piece of paper. Draw a lion next to the bush, a mouse underneath the bush, and a cheetah in front of the bush. Draw a zebra behind the bush (you might just be able to see his tail poking out) and a parrot on top of the bush.

Physical Development

Practise throwing and catching a ball or beanbag with someone at home. How many times can you throw and catch without dropping the ball? How high can you throw the ball and catch it again? Remember to hold your hands ready to catch.

Expressive Arts and Design

It is nearly Easter!

Can you design an Easter egg. You can paint it, crayon it, use different materials to make a collage, you can draw smaller eggs, chicks, flowers and perhaps an Easter bunny.

Literacy

Watch the Peter Rabbit-Easter special story on youtube.

Can you write about your favourite character and why? For eg. My favourite character is Peter Rabbit because he wants to help people and make them happy.

Or you can write your own story about Peter Rabbit.
