Reception Home Learning - Tuesday 24th March 2020

The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They **MUST** complete these tasks plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics

Draw circles on a piece of paper and put different coloured paints in shallow trays or use crayons to draw the petals. Choose a number between 1 and 20. Dip your finger into paint and add that many petals to one of the circles or draw that many petals with a crayon, making a flower. Count the petals to check how many you have and write that number in the middle of the circle. Choose another number and do the same to another circle on your page. Fill up your page with colourful flowers, each with different amounts of petals.

Understanding the World and Literacy

Encourage the use of time related language. For example, first, then next. Write about what you did when planting your seed yesterday e.g. First, I got a plant pot or I prepared the soil.

Communication and Language

Children to use a toy to tell a story to an adult.

Once the story has finished, ask questions about the story, or questions that will extend the story. What happens to (character)? Why did they do?

Technology

On an IPad or laptop, type in topmarks.co.uk and play a phonics and a maths games focussing on number recognition and missing numbers.
