Reception Home Learning - Wednesday 25th March 2020

The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They MUST complete these task plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics

If you can play the number song to 20 on an IPad or laptop.

Write out the numbers 0-20 on some paper or card, cut them up and then ask a grown up to mix the numbers up - don't peek! Then, see how quickly you can put them into the correct order. You could ask someone to time you and then see if you can get faster when you try again.

Understanding the World and Literacy

Can you draw me a picture of the witch from your story? Think about which colours you are going to use. Draw the outline with a pencil first and then colour her in.

Physical Development

Ask an adult to provide a timer.

How many star jumps can you do in 30 seconds? Can you beat your first attempt?
Talk about how long 30 seconds is. Did it feel like a long time? Can you count your own jumps?

Literacy

Can you write a story about a witch?
You can either use a witch you already know about from your favourite story or you can make one up. Is she a good witch or a bad one?
Does she ride on a broomstick or does she have other magical powers?

Be as imaginative as you can.
