Reception Home Learning - Thursday 26th March 2020

The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They MUST complete these task plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics

Listen to a number song to 20.

We are going to learn about sharing. Ask your child to get three teddies/people, say you have 6 sweets, raisins, apples, fruit that you would like to share equally between the teddies. Observe what your child does. If they are struggling model how you would do it and then give them another sharing activity.

To check their understanding, play an online game,

Then click on fair share and play the curious George game.

Understanding the World

Children to draw a picture of a flower.

Remember to draw some petals, a stem and some leaves. Can you then label it? Then can you draw what it needs to grow?

Expressive Arts and Design

Children are to follow your instructions and draw each part. Let them use their imaginations. Tell them you are going to give them some instructions and they are going to draw what you describe.

The sea is blue.

The sun is shining bright in the sky.

On the sea, there is a boat.

Two birds are flying high in the sky.

Literacy

Ask your child to write this sentence. Say it three times, each time asking him/her to repeat it after you. Then they write it down. Remembering finger spaces and a full stop.
