Reception Home Learning - Friday 27th March 2020

The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They MUST complete these task plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics

Listen to a number song counting backwards from 20. We learnt about sharing yesterday, let's see what you can remember by doing this task independently if you can. Go and get 5 toys, then get 10 pretend biscuits (bricks, bits of paper). Can you share them out between the 5 toys? How many will they have each? Remember they should be shared equally, which means they have the same each.

Physical Development

At school we learn to throw well. Please can you help the children by making targets (paper) with different numbers on and asking them to aim their ball to land on the number you say. You can use paper screwed up, a ball, a small bean bag, a teddy. Remember to look where you are aiming, hold the ball in one hand and throw it underarm. Adult may need to model it.

Understanding the World

Ask the children to find 5 things they think will float and 5 things they think will sink.

Talk about what sink and float mean. Before putting them in the water, ask the child to make a prediction about whether they think it will float or sink.

Literacy

Ask the children to draw a picture to match the sentence. As per yesterday, say the sentence three times and the child repeats, then they draw a picture to match it.
