#### Mathematics

Sing the number song to 20 and the backwards from 20.

Describe a 2D shape, remembering to say how many sides and corners it has. For eg; I am thinking of a shape, it has 3 corners and 3 sides? See who can guess the most shapes correctly.

Challenge: Can you draw one of the shapes you have guessed or described?
