## Mathematics

Listen to 'Learn 3D shapes for kids' 😊

Look around your house and garden and see what 3D shapes you can find.

Can you find...

a sphere?

a cuboid?

a cube?

What other 3D shape can you find?

Take a picture (if you want to) and try listing them or labelling them by sounding out the letters of the word.

Try and write the shape names independently, show your family how amazing you are at writing!

## Physical Development

Make an indoor/outdoor obstacle course. Ask an adult to help you design it so its energetic, do moves which involve crawling, skipping, jumping, hopping and perhaps balancing. Use pillows, chairs, blankets, skipping ropes BUT make sure it's SAFE!

## Literacy/Phonics
