Reception Home Learning - Thursday 23rd April 2020

The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They MUST complete these task plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics/Technology

We have learnt about estimation (guessing) and discussed more than and less than. I want you to grab a handful of stones, cereals, counters or whatever you can use, put them in a bowl and ask as adult to do the same. Don't count them, your challenge is to decide which bowl has more and which has less. Then see if you are correct by counting them.

Play Topmarks bug catcher game and see if you can help Curious George estimate how many coloured bugs he has more of.

Physical Development

You are going to read a story about a Giraffe who couldn't dance. I would like you to plan a dance that Gerald might be able to do. Could you rehearse it and perform it for you family?

Literacy/Phonics

I would like you to watch or read the story 'Giraffes Can't Dance' by Giles Andreae. It is about a Giraffe that can't dance.

I would like you to find out 4 facts about Giraffes.

- 1. Where do they live in the wild (habitat)?
- 2. What do they like to eat (diet)?
- 3. How tall do Giraffes grow (height)?
- 4. Write one of your own facts.

Write out each fact in a full sentence independently. Remember to check the sentence makes sense.

Expressive Arts and Design

Find a picture of a giraffe, Gerald if you want and can you draw or create your own giraffe.

Then stick your facts with it and send me a picture.
