

Reception Home Learning - Friday 24th April 2020

The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They **MUST** complete these task plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics

Listen to the monkey number song, 'counting back from 20.'

We are going to learn how to count back or subtract. You can use 10 raisins, fruit, bricks, counters, whatever you can find. Use a number line if required.

1. If you had 10 items, then you take 5 away, how many do you have left?
2. If you had 8 items, then you take 4 away, how many do you have left?
3. If you had 10 items, then you take 6 away, how many do you have left?

Challenge:- Now try and do a sum of your own.

Literacy/Phonics

Listen to the story 'Hippo has a Hat' by Julia Donaldson.

Ask an adult to read the sentence three times and then you will write it down.

Remember to use finger spaces, capital letter and full stop. Make sure you read it back to yourself.

The hippo has a pink and red hat.

Physical Development

Let's do some jumping.

- Jump on the spot
- Draw 4 circles on paper or on the floor and jump from one spot to another in any order.
- Hop on the spot

Expressive Arts and Design

Can you design a hat for the Hippo?

You can make it as colourful as you want to.

You can put flowers on it or you can put sparkles or spots on it.

You decide.
