The children will be sent four tasks to complete each day. They **MUST** complete these task plus reading their RWI books. An exercise book has been sent home for sentence writing and a blank book for any pictures they are asked to create.

Mathematics

We are still learning about subtraction or take away.

Can you fingerprint or draw 10 Buzzy Bees? Now cover two of those bees with a piece of paper and pretend they have flown away. Count how many there are left. Your number sentence would be:

$$10 - 2 = 8$$

Your independent challenge is to work out the number sentences below using your Buzzy Bees to help you.

- $10 - 1 =$
- $10 - 3 =$
- $10 - 4 =$
- $10 - 5 =$

Physical Development

Try throwing and catching a ball on the spot. Between throwing the ball and catching it you should clap your hands. You must clap quickly to make sure you don't drop the ball.

Literacy/Phonics

This week we are going to learn about Buzzy Bees but today I would like you to listen to the story of 'The Happy Bee' by Ian Beck.

If you were a Buzzy Bee, which flower would you visit and why? Draw a picture of the flower you would choose and write a sentence with your reason.

Expressive Arts and Design
