

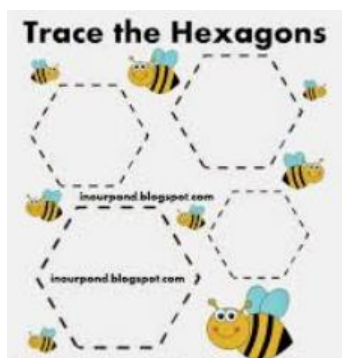

Bees make six sided shapes called hexagons in their hives, the hexagons fit together perfectly. It stores the pollen and honey that the worker bees bring to the hive.

Expressive Arts and Design Can you make a handprint bee? (See below) You can either use paints or you can colour it in using crayons or felt tips.



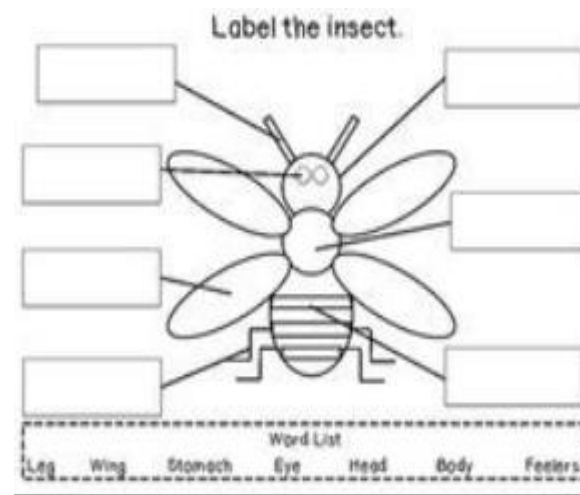
Literacy/Phonics
