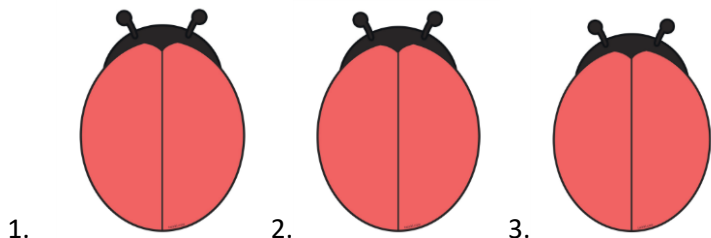

Mathematics

This week we are focusing on 'Minibeast'.

Listen to the 'counting with bugs' song by simple skits.

Can you draw three big ladybirds like this?



We are going to learn about doubling numbers.

1. On ladybird number 1, draw 2 dots on one side and 2 dots on the other side. How many do you have altogether? $2+2=?$
2. On ladybird number 2, draw 3 dots on one side and 3 dots on the other side. How many dots do you have altogether? $3+3=?$
3. On ladybird number 3, draw 5 dots on one side and 5 dots on the other side. How many dots do you have altogether? $5+5=?$

Challenge: can you draw another ladybird and make your own doubling sentence?
