Hello! Maths this week has moved on to co-ordinates, translation and reflection. In year five the children just need to concentrate on the first quadrant so I have suggested they only watch a portion of the videos so they don't become confused. If you feel they understand what they are doing however or would like further challenge they can watch the rest of the video and try the extension questions which go on to talk about the four quadrants.
