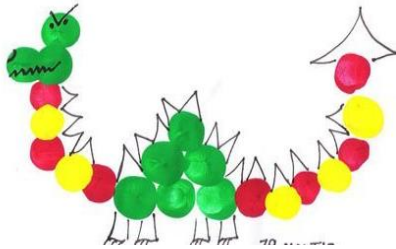

Play a game on topmarks on compare, order and measure length.

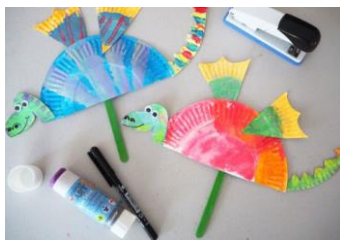
In the story Billy's dragon was small to begin with then he grew a abit bigger then he grew even bigger.
