

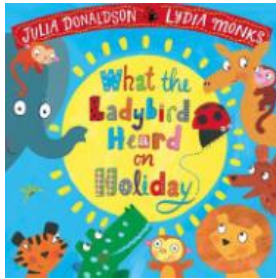
# Nursery Home Learning - Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2020

## Literacy

Listen to the story of 'What the Ladybird Heard on Holiday' written by Julian Donaldson.

The Ladybird is on holiday but whilst there she hears about a crime that is about to take place. Can she save the day even though she is on holiday?



Look at the pictures of the animals at the start and end of the book. Can you describe how they are different?

## PSHE

Think about what stealing means and why it is wrong. How would you feel if someone stole from you? What happens to people who steal things from others?

## Mathematics

Listen to a number song and play a topmarks number ordering game.

Can you sort the animals in the story in to two groups? Ask an adult to draw two big circles and you sort some of the animals. Which ones have two legs? Which have four legs? Which ones have a beak or a nose? How many other ways could you sort them?

## Art and Design

Look at the work of Andy Goldsworthy to find more examples of how nature can be used to make art. Use these as inspiration to make your own. Gather lots of leaves and try to arrange them to make a picture.
