Brain Builder Book

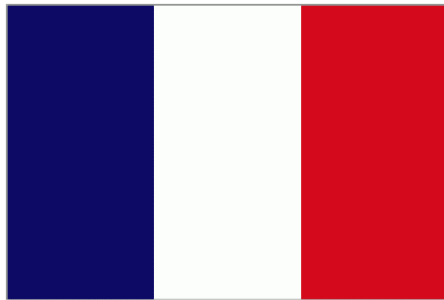

- English: Write a Book Review of your favourite book. What is the book about? Who is your favourite character and why? What is your favourite part of the book? Give some reasons why someone else should read the book. Draw your favourite part from the book.
- Maths: Ordering numbers worksheet.
