Mathematics

Watch Numberblocks S2 E5 (Number Ten). Encourage discussion afterwards. *What did you notice? What is special about Ten?*

Ask chn to look at their hands and to count their fingers. *How do you do this? e.g. Start with fingers down and hold them up; start with fingers up and hold them down. Which is easier? What else do you have 10 of? e.g. Toes.*

Can you find and count 10 objects? And write the number 10.

Art and Design

The story is about an Owl who is afraid of the dark. There are different species of owls, in the story they are barn owls.

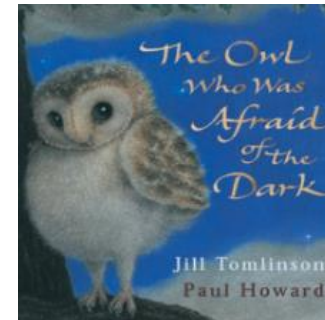
Have a look at a few pictures online.

Can you draw, paint or create a picture of a baby owl (owlet) Plop from the story? Think about texture (feels) and features (looks).



Literacy

Listen to the story 'The Owl who was afraid of the dark' written by Jill Tomlinson.



Tell an adult what happens in the story.

Phonics/Writing

Remember to complete the RWI lesson sent through Dojo. There is a speed sound lesson, word reading and spelling.

An additional task is to write a sentence. This is to be completed independently if they can.

Can you write a sentence about Plop? For eg. Plop is scared of the dark.

Think about your sentence, write it down slowly and then check it makes sense.
