Read Write Inc. is a fantastic program, we have been following it for 3 years and it has proven to be a successful and exciting way of learning to read and write. It helps the children learn the correct letter formation, letter sounds, blending and segmenting and also provides them with a love for reading.

As things are now beginning to return to normal in the school environment, we will have an open afternoon and tell you all about it in due course. It is so important during the early years of development that your child is read to on a regular basis even if it's the same storybook over and over again 😊.

In the coming weeks of the term, instead of show and tell, we will be sending Furness Fred home with a child. You will take pictures of the adventures he goes on and write about it and in time as your child starts to learn to read and write, they will write his diary. Kayleigh and your child will sit at the front of class and tell us all about the displayed photographs. Every child in the class will have the opportunity to do this so please do not worry.

## Rewards
