Since Team Peter was set up in June 2021, we have raised over £110K with support from the local community and beyond, so much so that Peter is now part of the clinical trial in the USA and has started this treatment to try and keep his cancer away. Raising funds for Team Peter will allow this treatment to continue for the next 2 years.
